■ RV Leather Care

Creative Colors International has several tips for extending and enhancing the life of leather upholstery in RVs.

1. The use of too much oil or wax can clog pores, causing leather to lose its ability to allow air in and moisture out. For best protection, use a mild dishwashing soap, such as Ivory liquid. Use one part Ivory to 10 parts water.

2. Dairy products that spill on darker dyed leather will leave a spot. After cleaning, the oils in

the dairy products will eventually rise back to the surface.

3. Lighter-colored leather needs to be cleaned often. Dirt, dust and clothing will leave traces on leather, especially black and dark-blue denim.

4. Never use preparations made for smooth leather on suede.
